AN ACT

RELATING TO VOTING; CLARIFYING THE PROCESS FOR EX-FELON VOTER
REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. [NEW MATERIAL] CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION.--

When a voter has been convicted of a felony, the voter's
registration shall be canceled.

Section 2. A new Section 1-4-27.2 NMSA 1978 is enacted to
read:

"1-4-27.2. [NEW MATERIAL] ELIGIBILITY FOR VOTING UPON
SATISFACTION OF CONDITIONS.--A person convicted of a felony
offense shall be restored the right to vote and shall be
eligible to register to vote if the person:

A. has completed the terms of a suspended or
deferred sentence imposed by a court;
