BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. PROHIBITION ON PAYMENT TO PLAINTIFFS' ATTORNEYS. --

- No funds shall be expended to pay attorney fees, expert witness fees or other expenses that may be claimed by plaintiffs' attorneys in the ACLU v. CYFD lawsuit and settlement, NM Dist. Ct., 1st Jud. Dist. No. D-0101-CV-2007-02921 or related cases.
