Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Resolution 15 proposes to amend article 4, section 5 of the Constitution of New Mexico to limit the number of special messages issued by the Governor to no more than twenty-five messages for the House of Representatives and twenty-five messages for the Senate for bills that may be considered during a regular session of an even-numbered year.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The Secretary of State, as the Chief Elections Officer is mandated to publish all constitutional amendments in both English and Spanish in a newspaper in every county statewide. The cost for the 2008 General Election was \$520,000 for five constitutional amendments. The cost breakdown is estimated at \$104,000 per constitutional amendment.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

Senate Joint Resolution 15 would constitutionally limit the number of Governor's messages during thirty day sessions of the Legislature to a maximum number of 25 messages to each chamber.
