WHEREAS, the league of women voters continues to advocate for responsible and responsive government at all levels and for the general welfare of the residents of New Mexico and the nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the league of women voters be congratulated on its ninetieth birthday and that February 14, .180109.1
