energy and providing for the nation's energy security is through advances in energy efficiency, including voltage regulation technology;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to direct the appropriate 2010 interim committee to include in its work plan review of tax incentives for voltage regulation technology in residences, businesses and agricultural enterprises; and
