## A RESOLUTION

AMENDING THE HOUSE RULES TO PROVIDE FOR TESTING THE ACCURACY OF THE ELECTRONIC VOTING SYSTEM.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that House Rule 21-7 be amended to read:

Roll call votes in the house may be taken by means of an electronic voting [machine] system.

Immediately prior to any regular, special or extraordinary session and at any time upon the order of the speaker, the accuracy of the electronic
