AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION; AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "FOOD" FOR THE GROSS RECEIPTS TAX DEDUCTION FOR RECEIPTS FROM THE SALE OF FOOD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 7-9-92 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2004, Chapter 116, Section 5) is amended to read:

"7-9-92. DEDUCTION--GROSS RECEIPTS--SALE OF FOOD AT RETAIL FOOD STORE.--

A. Receipts from the sale of food at a retail food store that are not exempt from gross receipts taxation and are not deductible pursuant to another provision of the Gross Receipts and Compensating Tax Act may be deducted from gross receipts. The deduction provided by this section shall be separately stated by the taxpayer.

4	2012(g)(1) for purposes of the federal food stamp program] is:
5	(a) an eligible food for purposes of the
6	special supplemental nutrition program for New Mexico women,
7	infants and children administered by the department of health;
8	(b) white flour tortillas; or
9	(c) fresh or frozen meat, poultry or
10	fish with no additional ingredients or only minimal additional
11	<u>ingredients</u> ; and
12	(2) "retail food store" means an establishment
13	that sells food for home preparation and consumption and that
14	meets the definition of retail food store in 7 USCA
15	2012[ <del>(k)</del> ] <u>(p)</u> (1) for purposes of the federal [ <del>food stamp</del> ]
16	supplemental nutrition assistance program, whether or not the
17	establishment participates in the [ <del>food stamp</del> ] <u>supplemental</u>
18	nutrition assistance program."
19	Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
20	provisions of this act is July 1, 2010.
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
