18	Section 1. Section 17-4-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,

23	[A. Any owner, lessee or person in control of lands
24	who, without charge or other consideration, other than a

1 government or any other governmental agency, grants permission 2 to any person or group to use his lands for the purpose of hunting, fishing, trapping, camping, hiking, sightseeing or any 3 other recreational use does not thereby: 4 5 (1) extend any assurance that the premises are safe for such purpose; or 6 7 (2) assume any duty of care to keep such lands safe for entry or use; or 8 9 (3) assume responsibility or liability for any injury or damage to or caused by such person or group; 10 (4) assume any greater responsibility, duty of 11 12 care or liability to such person or group than if such permission had not been granted and such person or group were 13 14 trespassers. B. A. Except as provided in Subsection C of this 15 section, an owner of property owes no duty of care to keep the 16 property safe for entry or use by a person or group for 17 recreational purposes or to give any warning of a dangerous 18 19 condition, use, structure or activity on the property to a 20 person or group entering for recreational purposes. B.
