15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. CHILD SUPPORT
17	A. A noncustodial parent shall not be liable for
18	child support for a child who is older than eighteen years of
19	age when that child elects not to have contact with the
20	noncustodial parent. This section applies to any parenting
21	agreement, whether or not the child in question is enrolled in
22	school.
23	B. For the purposes of this section, "contact"
24	means visitation in accordance with a parenting agreement
25	relating to the child in question.
