23	A. To qualify for state funding, a college of

25	secondary educational institution must instruct students in how
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1 to teach reading in courses that are based on current 2 scientifically based reading research and the science of 3 reading and which courses are aligned with public-education-4 department-adopted reading standards and include strategies and 5 assessment measures to ensure that beginning teachers are 6 proficient in teaching reading.

7 Β. No appropriation by the legislature to a public post-secondary educational institution shall be distributed to 8 9 a college of education or teacher preparation program that does not meet the requirements of Subsection A of this section. 10 The higher education department shall certify that the college of 11 12 education or teacher preparation program meets the requirements of that subsection. 13
