AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE EXPENDITURES; TRANSFERRING MONEY TO THE GENERAL FUND FROM OTHER STATE FUNDS OR ACCOUNTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MEETING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- SECTION 1. FUND TRANSFERS. -- Notwithstanding any restriction on the use of money in the funds, the following amounts from the following funds or accounts are transferred to the general fund for the purpose of meeting appropriations from the general fund:
- fifteen million three hundred forty thousand dollars (\$15,340,000) is transferred from the college affordability endowment fund;
- four million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$4,800,000) is transferred from the natural resources trustee
