AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; REQUIRING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO ADOPT RECYCLING PLANS FOR THE SALE OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS; PROVIDING THAT PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS BE USED TO FUND FINE ARTS EDUCATION PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the Public School Code is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] RECYCLING PLAN--PROCEEDS.--

- A. By July 1, 2013, all school districts shall adopt a recycling plan to address the collection, processing, marketing, disposition and sale of recyclable materials from public schools.
- B. All proceeds from the sale of recyclable materials shall be used to fund fine arts education programs."
