19	A. An animal that would otherwise be required to be
20	vaccinated against rabies pursuant to the provisions of Chapter
21	77, Article 1 or 1A NMSA 1978 may be exempted from such
22	requirement if that animal is the subject of a letter of
23	exemption as provided in Subsection B of this section.
24	B. A letter of exemption from the requirement for
25	rabies vaccination may be issued if a medical reason exists
