11	RELATING TO PUBLIC FINANCE; REQUIRING THAT CHAPTERS OF THE
12	NAVAJO NATION BE CERTIFIED AND THAT NONPROFIT ENTITIES BE
13	CHARTERED AND REGISTERED TO APPLY FOR AND IMPLEMENT CAPITAL

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 6-28-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2006,
18	Chapter 105, Section 2) is amended to read:
19	"6-28-2. FISCAL AGENTS FOR NAVAJO NATION PROJECTSThe
20	state recognizes [the] chapters of the Navajo Nation <u>that have</u>
21	been certified pursuant to the Navajo Nation Local Government
22	Act codified under Title 26 of the Navajo Nation Code as local
23	tribal entities having the capability and capacity to apply for
24	and implement capital improvement projects. The state also
25	recognizes [as local tribal entities those] <u>New Mexico</u>

1	nonprofit entities [organized under the supervision of tribal
2	governments] chartered by the Navajo Nation business regulatory
3	commission, registered with the public regulation commission
4	and whose mission or objective is to provide education, health,
5	welfare and other basic services [and who may] <u>as local tribal</u>
6	entities that have the capability and capacity to apply for and
7	implement and act as a fiscal agent for capital improvement
8	projects. Therefore, the state may contract through a
9	political subdivision of the state or a school board having
10	<u>local education authority as a</u> fiscal agent [other than the
11	Navajo Nation] for the expenditure of state funds on behalf of
12	local subgoverning tribal entities of the Navajo Nation.
13	[Unless otherwise negotiated, an administrative fee of no more
14	than five percent of a project's cost may be charged by the
15	entity that serves as fiscal agent.]"
16	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
17	provisions of this act is July 1, 2011.
