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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. Section 66-3-7 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
19	Chapter 35, Section 27, as amended) is amended to read:
20	"66-3-7. GROUNDS FOR REFUSING, SUSPENDING OR REVOKING
21	REGISTRATION OR CERTIFICATE OF TITLEThe division may refuse,
22	suspend or revoke registration or issuance of a certificate of
23	title or a transfer of registration upon the [ground] <u>grounds</u>
24	that:
25	A. the application contains a false or fraudulent

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statement or that the applicant failed to furnish the required information or reasonable additional information requested by the division or that the applicant is not entitled to the issuance of a certificate of title or registration of the vehicle under the Motor Vehicle Code;

Β. the vehicle is mechanically unfit or unsafe to be operated or moved upon the highways;

a commercial motor vehicle is operated by a C. commercial motor carrier that is prohibited from operating the vehicle by order of a state or federal agency;

the division has [a] reasonable [ground] grounds D. to believe that the vehicle is a stolen or embezzled vehicle or that the granting of registration or the issuance of a certificate of title would constitute a fraud against the rightful owner or other person having valid lien upon the vehicle;

Ε. the registration of the vehicle stands suspended or revoked for any reason as provided in the motor vehicle laws of this state;

> the required fee has not been paid; F.

G. the motor vehicle excise tax has not been paid;

н. the weight distance tax has not been paid;

I. international fuel tax agreement taxes have not been paid;

J. if the vehicle is a mobile home, the property .184400.2SA

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tax has not been paid;

2 Κ. the owner's address, as shown in the records of the division, is within a class A county or within a 3 municipality that has a vehicle emission inspection and 4 maintenance program and the applicant has applied at an office 5 outside the designated county or municipality; [or] 6 the owner is required to but has failed to 7 L. provide proof of compliance with a vehicle emission inspection 8 and maintenance program, if required in the county or 9 municipality in which the owner resides; or 10 M. the owner has failed to fulfill a signed promise 11 to appear or notice to appear in court as a consequence of a 12 charge or conviction pursuant to the Motor Vehicle Code or the 13 laws of a tribe, as evidenced by notice from a state or tribal 14 court." 15 SECTION 2. Section 66-8-128 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978, 16 Chapter 35, Section 536, as amended) is amended to read: 17 "66-8-128. UNIFORM TRAFFIC CITATION .--18 Α. The department shall prepare a uniform traffic 19 citation containing at least the following information: 20 (1)an information section, serially numbered 21 and containing spaces for the name, physical address and 22 mailing address, city and state of the individual charged; the 23 individual's physical description, age and sex; the 24 registration number, year and state of the vehicle involved and 25 .184400.2SA - 3 -

<u>underscored material = new</u> [bracketed material] = delete its make and type; the state and number of the individual's driver's license; the specific section number and common name of the offense charged under the NMSA 1978 or [of] local law; the date and time of arrest; the arresting officer's signature and identification number; and the conditions existing at the time of the violation;

(2) a notice to appear; [and]

(3) a penalty assessment notice with a place for the signature of the violator agreeing to pay the penalty assessment prescribed; <u>and</u>

(4) any additional requirements provided in writing by the administrative office of the courts.

B. The department shall prescribe how the uniform traffic citation form may be used as a warning notice.

C. The department shall prescribe the size and number of copies of the paper version of the uniform traffic citation and the disposition of each copy. The department may also prescribe one or more electronic versions of the uniform traffic citation, and these electronic versions may be used in the issuance of citations.

D. Any entity that wishes to submit uniform traffic citations required to be submitted to the department by electronic means [must] shall secure the prior permission of the department."
