15	SECTION 1. A new section of the Criminal Code is enacted

18	A. Bullying consists of a pattern of intentional
19	conduct, including physical, verbal, written or electronic
20	communication, that creates a hostile environment and
21	substantially interferes with another person's physical or
22	psychological well-being and that is:
23	(1) motivated by an actual or perceived
24	personal characteristic, including race, national origin,
25	marital status, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity,

familial status or a physical or mental ability or disability;
or
(2) threatening or seriously intimidating.
B. Whoever commits bullying is guilty of a petty

harm or substantial emotional distress is guilty of a
misdemeanor."
