17	SECTION 1. A new section of the Wildlife Conservation Act
18	is enacted to read:
19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] INTERSTATE WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT COMPACT
20	A. On recommendation of the commission, the
21	governor may enter on behalf of the state into compacts with
22	other states, at least one of which shall share a border with
23	New Mexico, to provide for the cooperative management of
24	endangered and threatened species.
25	B. Any compact entered into under the provisions of

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1 this section shall seek to achieve viable populations of 2 endangered or threatened species in locations compatible with 3 human activity. C. A compact for the purposes provided for in this 4 5 section shall: recognize and accommodate the unique 6 (1)7 management needs and challenges of the several distinct populations and subspecies of the various species present among 8 9 the participating states; provide for the administration of its 10 (2) provisions and public participation and comment in formulating 11 12 the policies, procedures and programs governed by the compact; include provisions for compiling and 13 (3) sharing data and other information, documents and electronic 14 files among the participating states, the state, federal 15 wildlife management agencies and the public; 16 include measures for addressing issues of 17 (4) human and endangered or threatened species interface, including 18 habitat overlap and depredation; and 19 20 (5) provide for uniform civil and criminal penalties for violation of the compact's provisions. 21 D. At least ninety days before the governor signs 22 the compact, the commission shall: 23 provide copies of the compact to the New (1)24 Mexico legislative council; 25 .185330.1

	2	the boards of county commissioners likely to be affected by the
	3	compact that a copy of the compact will be provided upon
	4	request; and
	5	(3) post the text of the compact on the
	6	commission's and department of game and fish's official web
	7	sites."
	8	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
	9	provisions of this act is July 1, 2011.
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
