12	RULES ACT TO SUSPEND THE EFFECTIVENESS OF CERTAIN RULES;
13	DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	SECTION 1. A new section of the State Rules Act is
17	enacted to read:
18	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] RECONSIDERATION OF A RULE
19	A. The following rules filed with the records
20	center and published in the New Mexico register shall be
21	ineffective on the effective date of this section until the
22	agency reconsiders the rule:
23	(1) Rules 20.2.350.1 through 20.2.350.400
24	NMAC, adopted by the environmental improvement board in 2010,
25	which adopt a cap-and-trade program dealing with greenhouse

3	NMAC, adopted by the environmental improvement board in 2010,

6	adopted by the environmental improvement board in 2007, which
7	adopt clean car standards for the state;
8	(4) Rules 20.11.104.1 through 20.11.104.112
9	NMAC, adopted by the Albuquerque-Bernalillo county air quality
10	control board in 2007, which adopt clean car standards for
11	Albuquerque and Bernalillo county; and
12	(5) Rules 11.1.2.11 and 11.1.2.12 through
13	11.1.2.13 NMAC, adopted by the labor and industrial commission
14	in 2010, which adopt requirements for establishing prevailing
15	wage and fringe benefit rates for public works projects.
16	B. When reconsidering a rule, the agency shall
17	start its rulemaking process from the beginning. If an agency
18	fails to complete this rulemaking process within one hundred
19	eighty days from the date of the effective date of this
20	section, the rule shall remain ineffective and shall be removed
21	from the New Mexico Administrative Code."
22	SECTION 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
23	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
