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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 66-3-419 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1990,
18	Chapter 46, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"66-3-419. SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR ARMED FORCES
20	VETERANS
21	A. The department shall issue distinctive
22	registration plates indicating that the recipient is a veteran
23	of the armed forces of the United States [as defined in Section
24	28-13-7 NMSA 1978] or is retired from the national guard or
25	military reserves if that person submits proof satisfactory to
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the department of honorable discharge from the armed forces or of retirement from the national guard or military reserves.

B. For a fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00), which [shall be] is in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees, any motor vehicle owner who is a veteran of the armed forces of the United States or is retired from the national guard or military reserves may apply for the issuance of a special registration plate, as defined in Subsection A of this section. No two owners shall be issued identically lettered or numbered plates.

C. The fifteen-dollar (\$15.00) fee provided in Subsection B of this section shall be waived for each registration period in which a validating sticker is issued under the provisions of Section 66-3-17 NMSA 1978, in lieu of the issuance of a special armed forces veteran plate.

D. Each armed forces veteran may elect to receive a veteran-designation decal to be placed [across the top of the plate, centered above the registration number] in a dominant and blank space on the registration plate as determined by the department. Replacement or different veteran-designation decals shall be available for purchase from the department at a reasonable charge to be set by the secretary. The department shall furnish the following veteran-designation decals with the armed forces veteran plate to a:

16	[(13)] <u>(7)</u> Vietnam veteran;
17	[(14)] <u>(8)</u> Korean veteran;
18	[(15)] <u>(9)</u> disabled Korean veteran;
19	[(16)] <u>(10)</u> World War II veteran;
20	[(17)] <u>(11)</u> World War I veteran;
21	[(18)] <u>(12)</u> Grenada veteran;

25	E. The revenue from the special registration plates

1 for the armed forces veterans fee imposed by Subsection B of 2 this section shall be distributed as follows: 3 (1) seven dollars (\$7.00) of the fee collected 4 for each registration plate shall be retained by the department 5 and is appropriated to the department for the manufacture and 6 issuance of the registration plates; and 7 eight dollars (\$8.00) of the fee collected (2) 8 for each registration plate shall be transferred pursuant to 9 the provisions of Subsection F of this section. 10 F. There is created in the state treasury the 11 "armed forces veterans license fund". A portion of the fee 12 collected for each special registration plate for armed forces 13 veterans, as provided in Subsection E of this section, shall be 14 transferred to the state treasurer for the credit of the fund. 15 Expenditures from the fund shall be made on vouchers issued and 16 signed by the secretary of veterans' services or [his] the 17 secretary's authorized representative upon warrants drawn by 18 the department of finance and administration for the purpose of 19 expanding services to rural areas of the state, including 20 Native American communities and senior citizen centers. Any 21 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of any 22 fiscal year in the armed forces veterans license fund shall not 23 revert to the general fund." - 4 -24 25

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
