1 under the Workers' Compensation Act, the director is empowered 2 to institute in [his] the director's own name an action in the district court of Santa Fe county or the county where the 3 employer resides or has [his] a principal office or place of 4 business to enjoin the employer from continuing [his] business 5 operations until [he] the employer has complied with the 6 7 provisions of Section 52-1-4 NMSA 1978, and upon a showing of the facts above recited, the court shall grant such injunction. 8 9 In any such action, the attorney general or district attorney for the judicial district where the action is brought shall 10 represent the director. The director is empowered to seek 11 12 reimbursement from the employer of all costs associated with the enforcement of Section 52-1-4 NMSA 1978, including but not 13 limited to the costs of service of process, recording fees and 14 locksmith expenses. Any reimbursement shall be deposited in 15 the workers' compensation administration fund; and 16
