BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 21, Article 1 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] ASSISTANTS CONSIDERED EMPLOYEES--EXCEPTIONS.--

Except as provided in Subsection B of this Α. section and except as otherwise provided by law, an individual employed as a graduate assistant, a teaching assistant, a research assistant or a project assistant by a public post-

secondary educational institution named in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico shall be considered an employee of that institution for all purposes.
