16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 66-5-503 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
18	Chapter 239, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"66-5-503. IGNITION INTERLOCK LICENSEREQUIREMENTS
20	EXCLUSIONS
21	A. A person whose driving privilege or driver's
22	license has been revoked or denied or who has not met the
23	ignition interlock license requirement as a condition of
24	reinstatement pursuant to Section 66-5-33.1 NMSA 1978 may apply
25	for an ignition interlock license from the division.

1 An applicant for an ignition interlock license Β. 2 shall: provide proof of installation of the 3 (1) ignition interlock device by a traffic safety bureau-approved 4 ignition interlock installer on any vehicle the applicant 5 drives; and 6 7 (2) sign an affidavit acknowledging that: operation by the applicant of any (a) 8 9 vehicle that is not equipped with an ignition interlock device is subject to penalties for driving with a revoked license; 10 (b) tampering or interfering with the 11 12 proper and intended operation of an ignition interlock device may subject the applicant to penalties for driving with a 13 license that was revoked for driving under the influence of 14 intoxicating liquor or drugs or a violation of the Implied 15 Consent Act; and 16 (c) the applicant shall maintain the 17 ignition interlock device and keep up-to-date records in the 18 19 motor vehicle showing required service and calibrations and be 20 able to provide the records upon request. [C. A person who has been convicted of homicide by 21 vehicle or great bodily injury by vehicle while under the 22 influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs, as provided in 23 Section 66-8-101 NMSA 1978, shall not be issued an ignition 24 interlock license.]" 25 .185420.1
