AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES; PROVIDING A MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEE EXEMPTION FOR LOW-INCOME DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 66, Article 6 NMSA 1978 is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] EXEMPTION FOR LOW-INCOME DISABLED PERSONS.--

- A disabled person who is a bona fide resident of New Mexico and has an annual income of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) or less shall be exempt from payment of any motor vehicle registration fees to the state on one vehicle per year owned by the person.
- B. As used in this section, "disabled person" means a person who:
