14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 73-20-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1965,
16	Chapter 137, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"73-20-28. SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION
18	MEMBERSThere is created a "soil and water conservation
19	commission" to be composed of seven appointed members and five
20	ex-officio members. The seven appointed members shall be
21	selected by [and serve at the pleasure of] the governor <u>and be</u>
22	confirmed by the senate. Six of the appointed members shall be
23	supervisors [and shall be selected and appointed from a panel
24	of three candidates] currently serving in an elected position
25	on a district board. One supervisor from each region [compiled

1 by the districts of each region and presented by the president 2 of the New Mexico association of conservation districts] shall be appointed from a list of candidates submitted by the 3 districts of each region to the director of the department. 4 One appointed member shall be selected at large and shall be a 5 person interested and active in the conservation or development 6 7 of natural resources in New Mexico. The five ex-officio members shall serve without vote and shall include: 8

9 A. the governor or [his] the governor's designee;
10 B. the associate director of the cooperative
11 extension service of New Mexico state university or [his] the
12 associate director's designee;

13 C. the associate director of the agricultural
14 experiment station of New Mexico state university or [his] the
15 associate director's designee;

D. the state conservationist of the natural resources conservation service of the United States department of agriculture or [his] <u>the state conservationist's</u> designee; and

E. the president of the New Mexico association of conservation districts or [his] the president's designee."

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2011.
