CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE W. KEN MARTINEZ

I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

**TORREON-STAR LAKE CHP SENIOR CTR**

four hundred twelve thousand two hundred fifteen dollars (\$412,215) to construct the senior center at the Torreon-Star Lake chapter within the eastern Navajo agency of the Navajo Nation in Sandoval county

- to the department of environment

**CEBOLLETA LAND GRANT REGIONAL WASTEWATER LAGOON**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct a regional wastewater lagoon for the communities of Seboyeta, Bibo and Moquino in the Cebolleta land grant in Cibola county

**MCKINLEY CO WATER REGIONALIZATION PROJECTS**

one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) to plan, design and construct water regionalization projects in McKinley county

**NW NM RGNL SOLID WASTE AUTH WALKING FLOOR TRAILERS**

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to purchase and equip walking floor trailers and trucks for the northwest New Mexico regional solid waste authority in Thoreau in McKinley county

**DINE COLLEGE CLASSROOMS-PLAN & DESIGN**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan and design classroom expansion at Dine college in Crownpoint in McKinley county

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### **CROWNPOINT CHP DEPT VET AFFAIRS PARKING LOT**

one hundred fifty-two thousand dollars (\$152,000) to plan, design and construct a parking lot at the Navajo Nation department of veterans affairs' facility in the Crownpoint chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **STANDING ROCK CHP SEWER SYSTEM**

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to construct and upgrade the sewer system in the Standing Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

### **LAKE VALLEY & WHITE ROCK CHPS WATER LINE CONSTRUCT**

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan, design and construct water line extensions to serve homes north of the Lake Valley and White Rock chapters of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

### **NAGEEZI CHP HOUSE WIRING**

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct electrical house wiring in the Nageezi chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

### **WHITE ROCK CHP BATHROOM PLUMBING**

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to design and construct bathroom plumbing for homes within the White Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

### **WHITE ROCK CHP POWERLINE CONSTRUCT**

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to design and construct powerline extensions in the White Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

### **GALLUP INDIAN MEDICAL CENTER LAND & CONSTRUCT**

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to purchase land for and to plan, design and construct the Gallup Indian medical center in McKinley county

### **MCKINLEY CO ROAD DEPT GRADERS & EQUIPMENT**

five hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000) to purchase and equip road graders and to purchase heavy equipment for the county road department in McKinley county

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### MCKINLEY CO REGIONAL JUDICIAL COMPLEX

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to purchase, construct, equip and furnish a regional judicial complex, including a shared facility with both magistrate and municipal courts, DWI office, drug courts, public defenders' office and other services, in Gallup in McKinley county

### MOTEL BLVD IMPROVE - MILAN

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including roadway, drainage and utilities, to Motel boulevard in Milan in Cibola county

### MCKINLEY CO ROAD 19 IMPROVEMENTS

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design and construct road, drainage and intersection improvements to county road 19 in McKinley county

### NMSU-GRANTS CHILD DEVELOPMENT CTR

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a child development center on the Grants campus of New Mexico state university in Cibola county
