CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR SENATOR GEORGE K. MUNOZ

I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

MCKINLEY CO WATER REGIONALIZATION PROJECTS

one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) to plan, design and construct water regionalization projects in McKinley county

- to the Indian affairs department

CHICHILTAH CHP FIRE STATION

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a fire station, including parking lots and fencing, in the Chichiltah chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

MANUELITO CHP HOUSE RENOVATE

three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) to design, construct and equip renovations to the chapter house, including the public kitchen and bathroom facilities, in the Manuelito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

MANUELITO CHP MOTOR GRADER & STORAGE WAREHOUSE

three hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$325,000) to purchase a motor grader and to plan, design and construct improvements to a warehouse for the grader in the Manuelito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

MANUELITO CHP POWERLINE EXTEND/HSE WIRING

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for powerline extensions and house wiring in the Manuelito chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

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PINEDALE CHP FIRE STATION

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a fire station in the Pinedale chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

PINEDALE CHP WASTEWATER/SEWER DISPOSAL PLANT

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a wastewater and sewer disposal plant in the Pinedale chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

RED ROCK CHP BATHROOM ADDITIONS

eight hundred thirty-three thousand dollars (\$833,000) to plan, design and construct bathroom additions in the Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

RED ROCK CHP SEWER UPGRADES

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design and construct improvements and renovation to the sewer system, including lines and lagoons, in the Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

ZUNI PUEBLO HEAD START PLAYGROUND EQUIP PURCHASE

sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to purchase and install playground equipment for the Zuni head start program in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

ZUNI PUEBLO TRIBAL JUDICIAL/LAW ENFORCEMENT CMLPX

one hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$160,000) to plan and design a tribal judicial and law enforcement complex in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

ZUNI PUEBLO WATER/WWATER INFRA-COMMERCIAL DVLP

five million dollars (\$5,000,000) to construct water and wastewater infrastructure for the commercial development area in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

ZUNI PUEBLO WIND ENERGY FEASIBILITY STUDY

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) for a feasibility study for wind energy in the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

ZUNI PUEBLO WWATER TREATMENT CELL CONSTRUCT

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to construct wastewater treatment cells at the Pueblo of Zuni in McKinley county

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RAMAH CHP BATHROOM ADDITIONS

four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to construct bathroom additions in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola and McKinley counties

PINE HILL SCHOOL ADMIN TECH CTR EQUIP - CIBOLA CO

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design, construct, acquire, furnish and equip the administrative technology center for the Pine Hill school of the Ramah Navajo school board located in Cibola county

GALLUP INDIAN MEDICAL CENTER LAND & CONSTRUCT

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to purchase land for and to plan, design and construct the Gallup Indian medical center in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO ROAD DEPT GRADERS & EQUIPMENT

five hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000) to purchase and equip road graders and to purchase heavy equipment for the county road department in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO REGIONAL JUDICIAL COMPLEX

seven hundred thousand dollars (\$700,000) to purchase, construct, equip and furnish a regional judicial complex, including a shared facility with both magistrate and municipal courts, DWI office, drug courts, public defenders' office and other services, in Gallup in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO ROAD 6 IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, widening and drainage, to county road 6, also known as Cousins road, in McKinley county

PINEHAVEN RD IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, widening and drainage, to Pinehaven road in McKinley county

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REHOBOTH-SUNDANCE ROAD IMPROVE

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design and construct road and drainage improvements, including chip sealing, widening, drainage and a roundabout, to Rehoboth-Sundance road in McKinley county

ALLISON RD CORRIDOR IMPROVE DESIGN-GALLUP

five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) to design Allison road corridor improvements, including bridge replacement, environmental clearances, right-of-way planning and acquisition and preliminary corridor design, in Gallup in McKinley county

REMNANT MESA RD IMPROVE

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, to Remnant Mesa road in the Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TAH-HAH-BAH WELL RD IMPROVE

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, to Tah-hah-bah Well road in the Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

UPROOTED TREE RD IMPROVE

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including chip sealing, to Uprooted Tree road in the Red Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county
