SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

The House Judiciary Committee substitute for House Bill 458 amends Section 66-8-128 to mandate including a physical and mailing address on the uniform traffic citation.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

According to the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD), HB 458 requires the Uniform Traffic Citation (UTC) to contain both a physical and mailing address. This information is not currently on the UTC. Law enforcement agencies have UTCs in stock. If passed, agencies will be required to destroy old citations and order the new citations at significant expense to the agencies.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

According to the AOC, the only address given on a uniform traffic citation today is the address as it appears on a driver's license. This, especially in rural areas of the state, is not the address where a defendant receives mail. Thus, it is possible that a warrant is issued for the defendant's arrest for failure to appear when notice is sent to the only address the court has which is the one on the citation. By adding mailing and physical address to the citation, the court can be assisted in sending any notices to the defendant's correct address and the possibility of a warrant is lessened.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

The courts are participating in performance-based budgeting. According to the AOC, this bill may have an impact on the measures of the courts in the following areas:

• Number of bench warrants issued for failure to appear
