#### **SUMMARY**

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 140 would enact a new section of the Motor Vehicle Code to authorize special blood donor recognition registration plates.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Senate Bill 140 provides for a fee of \$35.00 in addition to the regular motor vehicle registration fees for issuance of the special plate.

#### Senate Bill 140 – Page 2

The revenue from the additional fee would be appropriated to:

\$10.00 to the Taxation and Revenue Department to defray the cost of making and issuing the special plate.

\$25.00 to the Department of Health for the purpose of funding blood donation outreach and education.

The Revenue and Appropriation estimates in the tables above reflect a range of 100 to 1,000 blood donor registration plates issuances.

It is unknown if the ten dollar allocation to TRD covers the actual cost of producing a low volume special plate.

# **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

SB140 does not address whether or not an owner of a motor vehicle that applies for issuance of a special blood donor recognition registration plate would be required to provide verification that he/she is a blood donor.
