SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 362 amends Section 59A-17-7.1 NMSA of the Insurance Code to provide that an applicant's for motor vehicle liability insurance shall not be denied coverage by an insurance company based on a 'not at fault' accident.

The bill also provides that no insurer or insurance agent shall charge a fee in addition to the insurance premium for any kind of property or casualty insurance for personal, family or household needs, except in the case of a late payment charge.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There are no fiscal impacts to the state.

OTHER SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

According to the Public Regulation Commission (PRC):

There appears to be evidence that drivers who have been involved in not-at-fault accidents are somewhat more likely to have an at-fault accident in the future than those drivers who have not been involved in not-at-fault accidents.
