Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 3 requests that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to consider proposals for rules to convert to and make electronic communication and handout distribution available for interim committees. And that the rules, at a minimum, provide for polling by the staff of their respective committee members to determine those members who desire to receive committee information in electronic format rather than paper and to direct all entities testifying to the respective committees to work with staff to provide those members a copy of materials to be handed out in electronic format in addition to paper documents for those who wish to continue to receive hard copies.
