NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it honor cancer patients, survivors and their families, remember those people who have been lost to cancer and declare Thursday, February 3, 2011, as "Putting a Face on Cancer Day" in the senate; and
