# A RESOLUTION

"9-1 [The speaker shall appoint] All appointments to committees created by the house, except those committees where the members are designated in the motion creating them, [and all appointments] shall

"9-1-2 The speaker shall designate, [the chairmen] from the committee membership, the chairs and vice chairs of each committee when the committee is appointed."; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that House Rule 9-7 be amended to read:

"9-7 If the [chairman] chair is absent at any meeting, the [second member named in such committee] vice chair shall act as [chairman] chair at the meeting.".
