14	WHEREAS, House Rule 24-1 provides that the rules of the
15	house may be amended by a two-thirds' vote of the members of
16	the house or by a majority vote of the members of the house
17	upon the recommendation of the rules and order of business
18	committee;
19	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
20	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that House Rule
21	23-8-1 be amended to read:
22	"23-8-1 [The legislative council service is authorized to
23	produce] A live audio and video stream of the house
24	floor proceedings [that is] <u>shall be</u> accessible
25	through the legislature's web site in a manner

befitting the house of representatives, including an appropriate user interface, subject to the following:

(a) the stream shall begin as soon as practicable after the speaker has announced a quorum is present and shall terminate as soon as practicable after a motion to recess or adjourn has carried, or upon the order of the speaker; [The live 8 video stream shall be produced from cameras configured and operated in such a way that as much 10 of the chamber is displayed as practicable but that 11 12 no material on members' desks, computer monitors or similar devices can be read or viewed except as 13 14 would otherwise be possible with an unaided eye.] (b) during the prayer, the pledge of 15 allegiance, reading of the journal, introduction of 16 legislation, reports of committees, introduction of 17 guests, messages from the governor, the senate or 18 other state officers and announcements and 19 20 miscellaneous business, the live video image shall be of the entire chamber or the rostrum from the perspective of the rear of the chamber except as 22

> (c) during third reading of legislation, the live video image shall be of the member who has been

provided in Paragraph (d) of this rule;

3	that the live video image should instead be of the

7	debate is substantial, the live video image shall be
8	as if the house of representatives were on third
9	reading of legislation;
10	<u>(e) at no time shall the live video image be</u>
11	of the gallery or of any material on a member's
12	desk, computer monitor or similar device such that
13	the material can be read or viewed except as would
14	otherwise be possible with an unaided eye;
15	(f) the live stream shall not be archived;
16	(g) the provisions of this rule shall apply
17	when the house of representatives is meeting in the
18	committee of the whole, joint session with the
19	senate and when any standing committee of the house
20	of representatives is meeting in the chamber; and
21	(h) the stream shall carry a notice to the
22	effect that the stream is being produced for the
23	benefit of the public and any political use is
24	prohibited and that the stream is not an official
25	record of the house's proceedings. [The provisions
