19	OF NEW MEXICO that Senate Rule 7-12 be amended to read:
20	"7-12 <u>Each senator owes a duty to preserve the decorum of</u>
21	the senate. While the senate is in session, a
22	senator shall <u>devote the senator's time, attention</u>
23	and energy to the business of the senate and shall
24	not speak <u>in a disruptive manner</u> to another senator,
25	[ <del>or</del> ] read any newspaper, [ <del>while the journals or</del>

2	that detracts from the decorum of the senate,
3	communicate with any person concerning the substance

7	chamber or across the chamber when the president is
8	putting a question. [No] <u>A</u> senator shall <u>not</u> walk
9	between a senator who is speaking and the chair.".
