AN ACT

RELATING TO CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING; ESTABLISHING
CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS FOR THE ELECTION OF REPRESENTATIVES TO
THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS; CHANGING PROVISIONS OF THE ELECTION
CODE RELATING TO PRECINCTS; AMENDING, REPEALING AND ENACTING
SECTIONS OF THE NMSA 1978.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 1-15-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1969,
Chapter 240, Section 365, as amended) is amended to read:

"1-15-15. UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE--CONGRESSIONAL
DISTRICTS ESTABLISHED.--New Mexico is divided into three
congressional districts to be known and designated as
congressional district [~~number~~] one, congressional district
[~~number~~] two and congressional district [~~number~~] three."

SECTION 2. Section 1-15-16 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1991

1 C. Congressional district three is composed of
2 Bernalillo county precincts 31, 303, 551 through 559, 567 and
3 570 through 573; Catron county; Cibola county; Colfax county;
4 Curry county; De Baca county; Guadalupe county; Harding county;
5 Los Alamos county; McKinley county; Mora county; Quay county;
6 Rio Arriba county; Roosevelt county precincts 1, 2, 5 through
7 13, 15, 17 through 19 and 21; San Juan county; San Miguel
8 county; Sandoval county precincts 1 through 29, 51, 53 through
9 57, 74, 76, 78 and 79; Santa Fe county; Socorro county
10 precincts 14, 15 and 26; Taos county; Torraine county; and
11 Union county."

12 SECTION 3. Section 1-15-16.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1991
13 (1st S.S.), Chapter 7, Section 2) is amended to read:

14 "1-15-16.1. PRECINCTS.--

15 A. Precinct designations and boundaries used in the
16 [~~1991~~] 2011 congressional redistricting are those precinct
17 designations and boundaries established pursuant to the
18 Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and revised and approved
19 pursuant to that act by the secretary of state as of [~~August~~
20 ~~16, 1991~~] August 31, 2011.

21 B. The boards of county commissioners shall not
22 create any precinct that lies in more than one congressional
23 district, nor shall the boards of county commissioners divide
24 any precinct so that the divided parts of the precinct are
25 situated in two or more congressional districts. Votes cast in

1 any general, primary or other statewide election from precincts
2 created or divided in violation of this subsection shall be
3 invalid and shall not be counted or canvassed."

4 SECTION 4. TEMPORARY PROVISION--COMPILATION

5 INSTRUCTIONS.--The compiler shall remove from the NMSA 1978 the
6 provisions of Section 1-15-15.1 NMSA 1978 (copy of
7 congressional districts established by Final Judgment and Order
8 in *Jepsen v. Vigil-Giron*, D-0101-CV-2001-02177 (1st Dist. Ct.,
9 filed January 8, 2002)).
