16	SECTION 1. Section 53-11-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967,
17	Chapter 81, Section 3) is amended to read:
18	"53-11-3. PURPOSESCorporations may be organized under
19	the Business Corporation Act for any lawful purpose or
20	purposes, except banking, insurance, credit unions, savings and
21	loan associations, railroads and waterworks organized under
22	[the Laws of 1887, Chapter 12] Sections 62-2-1 through 62-2-19,
23	62-2-21 and 62-2-22 NMSA 1978; provided that any entity
24	organized under the Business Corporation Act shall not have the
25	power to expend money to influence the outcome of any state,

2 SECTION 2. Section 53-17-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1967, 3 Chapter 81, Section 103, as amended) is amended to read: ADMISSION OF FOREIGN CORPORATION .-- No foreign 4 "53-17-1. 5 corporation shall transact business in this state until it has procured a certificate of authority to do so from the 6 7 commission; provided that no foreign corporation may procure a 8 certificate of authority unless the foreign corporation agrees 9 not to expend money to influence the outcome of any state, 10 county or local election. No foreign corporation shall procure a certificate of authority under the Business Corporation Act 11 12 to transact in this state any business [which] that a corporation organized under the Business Corporation Act is not 13 14 permitted to transact. A foreign corporation shall not be denied a certificate of authority because the laws of the state 15 or country under which the corporation is organized governing 16 its organization and internal affairs differ from the laws of 17 18 this state, and nothing in the Business Corporation Act 19 authorizes this state to regulate the organization or the 20 internal affairs of such corporation. Without excluding other activities [which] that may not constitute transacting business 21 in this state, a foreign corporation shall not be considered to 22 be transacting business in this state, for the purposes of the 23 Business Corporation Act, by reason of carrying on in this 24 state any one or more of the following activities: 25
