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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the
19	"Native American Veteran Housing Act".
20	SECTION 2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Native American
21	Veteran Housing Act:
22	A. "department" means the department of finance and
23	administration;
24	B. "fund" means the Native American veteran housing
25	fund;
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1 C. "Native American veteran" means an enrolled 2 member of a tribe who has been discharged under conditions other than dishonorable from service in the United States army, 3 navy, marine corps, air force or coast guard; 4 "tribe" means a federally recognized Indian 5 D. nation, tribe or pueblo located wholly or partially in New 6 7 Mexico that has entered into a class III tribal-state gaming compact with the state; and 8 "trust land" means land located within the 9 Ε. boundaries of a tribe or land held in trust by the United 10 States for benefit of a tribe. 11 12 SECTION 3. FUND CREATED--ADMINISTRATION.--13 Α. The "Native American veteran housing fund" is 14 created in the state treasury. The department shall administer the fund. 15 Β. Distributions from the general fund made 16 17 quarterly by the legislature pursuant to the Native American 18 veteran housing fund shall be deposited in the fund. Earnings 19 on the fund shall be credited to the general fund. 20 C. Balances in the fund are appropriated to the department to fund a program to assist Native American veterans 21 to buy, build or repair a home on trust land. Distributions 22 from the fund shall be made by warrant issued by the secretary 23 of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers signed by 24

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the secretary of finance and administration or the secretary's

1 designee.

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D. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall revert to the general fund.

QUARTERLY DISTRIBUTIONS--APPROPRIATIONS.--An 5 SECTION 4. amount equal to one percent of the net receipts of revenue 6 7 sharing paid quarterly to the state pursuant to a 8 revenue-sharing agreement pursuant to Section 11-13-2 NMSA 1978 9 by a tribal government is appropriated from the general fund in 10 fiscal year 2013 and in each subsequent fiscal year to the 11 Native American veteran housing fund to carry out the purposes 12 of the Native American Veteran Housing Act. Distributions 13 shall be made on a quarterly basis by the twenty-fifth day of 14 the month following the receipt of the quarterly revenuesharing payment from a tribe. Any unexpended or unencumbered 15 16 balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall revert to 17 the general fund.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2012.

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
