11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A FEASIBILITY AND MARKET STUDY FOR
12 A NATIONAL NAVAJO CODE TALKERS MUSEUM AND VETERANS CENTER.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred seventy-five
16 thousand dollars (\$175,000) is appropriated from the general
17 fund to the Indian affairs department for expenditure in fiscal
18 year 2013 to conduct a feasibility and market study regarding
19 visitors and traffic at a national Navajo code talkers museum
20 and veterans center located in McKinley county. Any unexpended
21 or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year
22 2013 shall revert to the general fund.
