CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE PAUL C. BANDY

I request that the following be funded:

- to the department of environment

SOUTHSIDE MDWA WATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to plan, design and construct water system improvements, including replacing water lines, for the Southside mutual domestic water association in San Juan county

AZTEC WATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

one million three hundred thousand dollars (\$1,300,000) to plan, design and construct water system improvements, including a water tank and water lines, in Aztec in San Juan county

AZTEC WWATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

one million seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$1,750,000) to purchase rights of way and property for, plan, design, construct and equip wastewater system improvements in Aztec in San Juan county

BLOOMFIELD WATER REUSE SYSTEM

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install a water reuse system in Bloomfield in San Juan county

SAN JUAN CO SALMON RUINS MUSEUM & LIBRARY EXPAND

five hundred sixty-four thousand nine hundred twenty-five dollars (\$564,925) to construct the expansion of the Salmon Ruins museum and library, including renovating restrooms, in San Juan county

AZTEC CENTRAL WIRELESS INTERNET ACCESS INSTALL

one hundred fifteen thousand dollars (\$115,000) to construct, equip and install wireless internet access along Main street and central corridors throughout Aztec in San Juan county

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to series 4000 county roads in San Juan county

two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) to construct the east Aztec arterial route project in Aztec in San Juan county
