CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE RAY BEGAYE

I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

LOWER VALLEY SENIOR CTR IMPROVE

two hundred sixty-four thousand dollars (\$264,000) to plan, design, construct and equip improvements, including demolition and landscaping, to the Lower Valley senior center in San Juan county

- to the public education department

BLOOMFIELD SCHL DIST PLAYGROUND & SECURITY UPGRADE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including upgrading playgrounds, designing play areas, fencing, security lighting and other safety-related improvements, in the Bloomfield school district in San Juan county

PUBLIC SCHOOL ROBOT SYS STATEWIDE

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to plan, design, purchase and install robot systems to equip students for science, technology, engineering and math competitions at public schools statewide

- to the Indian affairs department

SAN JUAN CHP ROAD GRADER & BACKHOE

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to purchase and equip a road grader and backhoe for the San Juan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

DINE COLLEGE SHIPROCK CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE

one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) to plan, design and construct infrastructure improvements to the Shiprock campus of Dine college in Shiprock in San Juan county

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DINE COLLEGE SHIPROCK CAMPUS VEHICLE PURCHASE

one hundred thirty-five thousand dollars (\$135,000) to purchase and equip a passenger van for the Shiprock campus of Dine college in San Juan county

DINEH WATER USERS ASSN EXCAVATOR-SAN JUAN CO

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to purchase and equip an excavator for the Dineh water users association in Shiprock in San Juan county

TSE'DAA'KAAN CHP PARKING LOTS IMPROVE

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to pave parking lots for the senior center, head start center and chapter house of the Tse'Daa'Kaan chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

SANTA FE INDIAN SCHL ENTRANCE

five hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$525,000) to construct an entrance to the Santa Fe Indian school in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

THOREAU COMMUNITY CTR KITCHEN RENOVATE

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to renovate the kitchen in the community center in Thoreau in McKinley county

FARMINGTON CIVIC CTR EXHIBIT HALLS REMODEL

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to remodel the exhibit halls in the civic center in Farmington in San Juan county

FARMINGTON MUSEUM EXPANSION

two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) to design and construct the expansion of the Farmington museum in Farmington in San Juan county

FARMINGTON REGIONAL ANIMAL SHELTER

three million five hundred thirty-one thousand dollars (\$3,531,000) to plan, design and construct the regional animal shelter in Farmington in San Juan county

KIRTLAND RECREATIONAL COMPLEX IMPROVE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to construct improvements to and equip the Kirtland recreational complex in San Juan county

PINON HILLS BLVD EXTENSION PROJECT

twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to design and construct the Pinon Hills extension project, which extends Pinon Hills boulevard east from New Mexico highway 516 south to county road 3000 in San Juan county

SAN JUAN CO SERIES 6000 RDS IMPROVE

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for materials for surface improvements to series 6000 roads in San Juan county

US HWY 371/N 36 INTERSECTION IMPROVE

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct improvements, including signal lights, streetlights and highway expansion, at the United States highway 371 and Navajo route 36 intersection in San Juan county
