CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE THOMAS A. ANDERSON

I request that the following be funded:

- to the public education department

SOUTHWEST AERONAUTICS CHARTER SCHL SMART LAB

sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000) to plan, design, purchase and install a smart lab, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, at the Southwest Aeronautics, Mathematics and Science Academy charter school in Bernalillo county

PUBLIC SCHOOL ROBOT SYS STATEWIDE

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to plan, design, purchase and install robot systems to equip students for science, technology, engineering and math competitions at public schools statewide

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

ALB BERN CO SOUTHWEST MESA LIBRARY CONSTRUCT

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct a full-service library for the southwest mesa of Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

ALB ROUTE 66 VISITOR CENTER PURCHASE

eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) to plan, purchase, furnish and equip a Route 66 visitor's center on west Central avenue in Bernalillo county

PARADISE HILLS LITTLE LEAGUE CONSTRUCT-BERN CO

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish little league fields for the Paradise Hills little league in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

LA PAZ/PARADISE BLVD TRAFFIC SIGNALS

one hundred seventy thousand dollars (\$170,000) to plan, design, construct, purchase and install traffic signals at La Paz boulevard and Paradise boulevard in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

PASEO DEL NORTE BLVD/I-25 INTERCHANGE

forty-six million five hundred thousand dollars (\$46,500,000) for right-of-way acquisition, planning, designing and constructing the Paseo del Norte boulevard and interstate 25 interchange, including a north-to-west flyover from interstate 25 to Paseo del Norte, an east-to-south free-flow on-ramp from Paseo del Norte to interstate 25 and a grade-separated interchange at Paseo del Norte and Jefferson boulevard, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county
