I request that the following be funded:

GILA VALLEY MALDONADO DAM IMPROVE

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for improvements to the Maldonado dam for the upper Gila valley arroyos watershed district in Grant county

• to the department of environment

HOPE FARMS RD WWATER LINES CONSTRUCT-SOCORRO

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design, construct and equip wastewater collection lines on Hope Farms road in Socorro in Socorro county

• to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

CATRON CO FAIR EMERGENCY MGMT FCLTY BLDG CONSTRUCT

two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish an emergency management facility building at the county fairgrounds in Catron county

CATRON CO HEALTH CLINIC CONSTRUCT

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish the county health clinic in Reserve in Catron county

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, upgrade, equip and furnish the swimming pool and related areas in the Brancheau physical education complex at western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county

WNMU FLEMING HALL RENOVATE

two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to plan, design, construct, equip, upgrade and renovate Fleming hall at western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county

WNMU INFO TECH

eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture, infrastructure and storage technology, at western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county

WNMU LAND PURCHASE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to purchase land bordering western New Mexico university in Silver City in Grant county
