SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 182 appropriates \$100.0 thousand from the general fund to DFA for expenditure in fiscal year 2012 and subsequent years for San Juan County for a golfing program for indigent youth. The bill has an emergency clause.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$100.0 thousand contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of any fiscal year shall not revert.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

CYFD states the proposed bill to fund a golfing program as a physical activity for the indigent youth offers many positive advantages such as: developing character, sportsmanship, social skills, self-esteem, exercise, and healthy physical activity habits.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

According to DFA, San Juan County officials would need to set up an implementation plan and determine if additional personnel would be needed to identify disadvantaged youth that could benefit from this recreational golfing program. Performance benchmarks for program success should be established.
