11	DECLARING FEBRUARY 14, 2012 AS "ALZHEIMER'S DAY" IN THE SENATE.

13	WHEREAS, an estimated thirty-eight thousand New Mexicans
14	suffer from Alzheimer's disease; and
15	WHEREAS, eighty percent of home care for those with
16	Alzheimer's is provided by family members; and
17	WHEREAS, in 2010, more than one hundred thousand
18	caregivers provided more than one hundred fourteen million five
19	hundred thousand hours of unpaid care to New Mexicans suffering
20	from Alzheimer's disease; and
21	WHEREAS, the total value of this unpaid care is more than
22	one billion three hundred million dollars (\$1,300,000,000); and
23	WHEREAS, the number of people worldwide with Alzheimer's
24	and other types of dementia is rising substantially, with
25	dementia prevalence expected to double every twenty years, to

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 14, 2012 be declared "Alzheimer's Day" in the senate; and
