DECLARING THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 18 THROUGH FEBRUARY 25, 2012 "NATIONAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP WEEK" IN THE SENATE.

WHEREAS, according to the United States department of commerce, more than twenty-three thousand people become independent entrepreneurs daily, joining the more than twenty million self-employed that make up more than seventy-five percent of the nation's twenty million-plus business firms nationwide; and

WHEREAS, the national governors association encourages connecting education to economic growth industries, recognizing that entrepreneurship and small business creation are the growth engines of any economy; and
