AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INTERVENTIONS FOR STUDENTS AT LOW-PERFORMING SCHOOLS WITH GRADES OF D OR F IN SCHOOL YEAR 2011-2012 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE A-B-C-D-F SCHOOLS RATING ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--

A. Four million three hundred thousand dollars (\$4,300,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the following departments for expenditure in fiscal year 2013 to provide programs to assist students who are enrolled in public schools that have been ranked with a D or F grade during the 2011-2012 school year according to the provisions of the A-B-C-D-F Schools Rating Act in the following amounts for the following purposes:
