I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

CHURCH ROCK CHP SENIOR CTR

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and prepare a site for a senior center in the Church Rock chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

ZIA PUEBLO SENIOR CTR IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to the kitchen and storage areas of the senior center in the Pueblo of Zia in Sandoval county

PUBLIC SCHOOL ROBOT SYS STATEWIDE

three hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$320,000) to plan, design, purchase and install robot systems to equip students for science, technology, engineering and math competitions at public schools statewide

four hundred forty-four thousand dollars (\$444,000) to plan, design and construct a storm water drainage diversion, seal Chairamonte mine and increase neighborhood detention pond capacity in Gallup in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to plan, design and construct water system improvements for the communities of Rehoboth, Yah-ta-hey, Williams Acres, Gamerco and Ramah in McKinley county

RAMAH CHP GOV OFFICE BLDG

nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) to plan, design and construct the government office complex in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP SEWER LAGOON/EXTEND/LINES

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design and construct sewer system improvements, including lagoon, lines and extension of the system, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design and construct the solid waste transfer station in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP WATER SYSTEM IMPROVE

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct water system improvements, including wells, storage facilities and lines, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

GALLUP INTERTRIBAL CEREMONIAL CONSTRUCT & EQUIP

eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) to plan, design, construct and equip facilities, furnishings and exhibits and to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for the Gallup intertribal ceremonial in Gallup in McKinley county

TSE'II'AH I CHP PARKING LOT CONSTRUCT

two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) to construct a parking lot in the Tse'ii'ahi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TOHATCHI CHP RED WILLOW FARM WATER SYS IMPROVE

five hundred eighty-eight thousand dollars (\$588,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to the water system, including water well infrastructure, for the Red Willow farm in the Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

TOHATCHI CHP VETERANS HOUSING

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design and construct veterans housing in the Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county

SHEEPSPRINGS CHP SOLAR ELEC SYSTEMS

three hundred ten thousand dollars (\$310,000) to design and construct solar photovoltaic systems for the Sheepsprings chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

T'IISTOH SIKAAD CHP VETERANS COMPLEX

one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a veterans multi-complex building for the T'iistoh Sikaad chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

NAPI WATER SYSTEM PIPELINE IMPROVE

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to design and construct pipeline and water system improvements for the Navajo agricultural products industry municipal system in the Upper Fruitland chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county

SANTA ANA PUEBLO POLICE SUBSTATION CONSTRUCT

six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip a police substation, including temporary holding facility, in the Pueblo of Santa Ana in Sandoval county

MCKINLEY CO ROAD DEPT HEAVY EQUIPMENT

seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to purchase heavy equipment for the county road department in McKinley county

GALLUP COMMUNITY PANTRY IMPROVE

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to the Gallup community pantry in McKinley county

GALLUP FIRE STATION 1 IMPROVE

eight hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$881,000) to plan, design and construct improvements and additions to fire station number 1 in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP SPORTS COMPLEX

two million eight hundred ninety-seven thousand dollars (\$2,897,000) to construct and renovate the multipurpose sports complex, including installing turf, drainage, lighting, asphalt overlay, concession area and restroom improvements and tennis and basketball courts, in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP VETERANS' MEMORIAL CEMETERY

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design and construct a veterans' cemetery in Gallup in McKinley county

MCKINLEY CO REGIONAL JUSTICE CENTER

fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to construct, equip and furnish a regional justice center in McKinley county

- to the New Mexico mortgage finance authority

GALLUP AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT CONSTRUCT

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design and construct an affordable housing development in Gallup in McKinley county pursuant to the provisions of the Affordable Housing Act

SUNDANCE RD CORRIDOR IMPROVE

one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to the Sundance road county emergency corridor in McKinley county

SUPERMAN CANYON ROAD/CO RD 43 IMPROVE

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to Superman canyon road, also known as county road 43, in McKinley county

ALLISON RD CORRIDOR IMPROVE DESIGN-GALLUP

five hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$560,000) to design Allison road corridor improvements, including bridge replacement, environmental clearances, right-of-way planning and acquisition and preliminary corridor design, in Gallup in McKinley county

COAL AVE IMPROVE & ROW-GALLUP

five hundred twenty-six thousand dollars (\$526,000) to plan, design and construct improvements and acquire rights of way for an alley on Coal avenue in Gallup in McKinley county

EAST NIZHONI BLVD PEDESTRIAN SAFETY-GALLUP

ninety-five thousand dollars (\$95,000) to plan, design and construct accessible pedestrian pathways, including curb, gutter, sidewalks and driveways, along East Nizhoni boulevard from Second street to Red Rock drive in Gallup in McKinley county

GALLUP AIRPORT PARKING LOT

one hundred forty-one thousand dollars (\$141,000) to plan, design and construct the terminal and hangar parking lots at the municipal airport in Gallup in McKinley county

HOSPITAL DRIVE IMPROVE GALLUP

five hundred twenty-eight thousand dollars (\$528,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to Hospital drive in Gallup in McKinley county

OLD ZUNI ROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT GALLUP

two hundred ten thousand dollars (\$210,000) to acquire rights of way and to plan, design and replace the bridge on Old Zuni road in Gallup in McKinley county

US ROUTE 66 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVE

four hundred sixty-four thousand dollars (\$464,000) to plan, design and construct traffic calming and pedestrian safety improvements to downtown United States route 66 in Gallup in McKinley county

BIA ROUTE 9652 IMPROVE-NASCHITTI CHP

ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) to plan, design and construct improvements to bureau of Indian affairs route 9652 in the Naschitti chapter of the Navajo Nation in San Juan county
