19	A. An oilfield equipment transport vehicle may be
20	issued a special permit to transport loads for multiple trips
21	pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978. The area covered by
22	the special permit shall be specified on the permit.
23	B. The multiple trip special permits for oilfield
24	equipment transport vehicles may be issued for a load with a
25	maximum width not to exceed twenty-two feet, a maximum height
