18	A. A state agency may agree to a buy-out of an
19	employment contract only if a buy-out is required by the terms
20	of the employment contract, which contract has been in force
21	for at least one hundred eighty days prior to the effective
22	date of:
23	(1) the termination of that contract for any
24	reason; or
25	(2) the resignation of the public employee.

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1 A buy-out of an employment contract or a Β. 2 settlement agreement pursuant to a lawsuit regarding the employment contract brought by the public employee shall not 3 exceed the lesser of: 4 (1) the annual salary provided for in the 5 employment contract; or 6 7 (2) the salary of the governor for the immediate prior calendar year. 8 The term of an employment contract containing a 9 C. buy-out provision shall not exceed two years. 10 D. As used in this section: 11 12 (1)"buy-out" means a payment of unearned compensation, severance allowance or other remuneration to a 13 14 public employee upon: the resignation of the public (a) 15 employee prior to the stated termination date of that contract; 16 17 or the termination for any reason of an 18 (b) employment contract prior to the stated termination date of 19 20 that contract; "employment contract" means an agreement (2) 21 between a public employee and a state agency for the rendition 22 of services, including professional services; 23 "public employee" means any officer or (3) 24 employee of a state agency to whom a salary is paid from public 25 .191213.3 - 2 -

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funds for services rendered; and (4) "state agency" means the state or any of its branches, agencies, departments, boards, instrumentalities or institutions. SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY.--The provisions of this act apply to employment contracts entered into, extended or renewed after June 30, 2013. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the SECTION 3. provisions of this act is July 1, 2013. - 3 -.191213.3

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
