AN ACT

RELATING TO GAME AND FISH; AMENDING A SECTION OF CHAPTER 17,
ARTICLE 3 NMSA 1978 TO PROVIDE A PERIOD FOR LICENSES ISSUED
UNDER CHAPTER 17 NMSA 1978 TO LAST FOR ONE YEAR FROM THE DATE
OF ISSUANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 17-3-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1964 (1st
S.S.), Chapter 17, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"17-3-1. CURRENT LICENSE REQUIRED.--Each license issued
under Chapter [~~53 New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1953~~
~~Compilation~~] 17 NMSA 1978 runs [~~from April 1 through March 31~~
~~of the following calendar year~~] for one year from the date of
issuance. No person shall shoot, hunt, kill, injure or take,
in any manner, any game animal, game bird or game fish without
paying for, and having in [~~his~~] the person's possession, the
